



What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Iceland

Day 2: Reykjavik

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Reykjavik. Unable to decide if it's a small town or a big city, Reykjavik happily provides visitors with the best of both. While visiting you'll explore quaint seaside streets dotted with eclectic and colorful homes while also taking advantage of the capital city's unforgettable culture, shopping and cuisine. Later in the tour you'll have a chance to get away from it all at the Blue Lagoon, the country's most famous natural wonder. Bathe in this mineral-rich seawater fed from a nearby geothermal plant, which is considered by many to hold incredible healing properties. As you are covered in white mud and surrounded by steam, you'll appreciate the beauty and rejuvenating effects delivered by these milky blue waters.
- Take a tour of Reykjavik
- Visit the National Museum

Day 3: Hvolsvöllur area

- Today you will explore the Golden Circle. Spanning a nearly 200-mile loop from Reykjavik into central Iceland, the Golden Circle encompasses many of the country's famous natural wonders. Your loop begins at Thingvellir National Park, which is home to Thingvallavatn, the largest natural lake in Iceland and a site of historical and geological importance. Be sure to have your camera ready at your next stop—the breathtaking waterfall, Gullfoss, or Golden Falls. Then, watch water go up instead of down at the Geysir geothermal area. Here, the Great Geysir hurls boiling water more than 200 feet into the air, a sight that's not to be missed.
- Take an excursion to Thingvellir National Park
- Take a geology walk
- Visit Gullfoss waterfall
- Visit the Geysir geothermal area
- Learn about geyser cooking
- Travel to the Hvolsvöllur area
- Visit a greenhouse powered by geothermal and hydroelectric energy

Day 4: Hvolsvöllur area

- Take an excursion to Thorsmork Glacier Valley
- Visit the Thorvaldseyri Farm and learn how the 2010 volcanic eruption affected cattle and wheat production
- Visit the Seljalandsfoss and Skógarfoss waterfalls, two of south Iceland's most famous natural wonders. Seljalansfoss is a beautiful, 130-foot-high waterfall on the river Seljalandsá, while Skógarfoss is on the river Skógaá and has the title of one of the biggest in the country with a width of 80 feet and a drop of 200 feet. Legend has it that Prasi Pórólfsson—the first Viking settler in the area—buried a treasure in a cave behind it. On the eastern side, you'll be able to see the Sólheimajökull glacier. Cap your excursion with a visit to the Skógarfoss Folk Museum.
- Visit the Skógarfoss Folk Museum
- Travel to the village of Vík
- Time to explore Vik or
- Glacier Walk

Day 5: Reykjavik

- Take a hike in Reykjadalar valley
- Visit natural hot streams and geothermal springs
- Travel to Reykjavik

Day 6: Reykjavik | Depart for home

- Take an excursion to Alftanes peninsula
- See Bessastaðir, official residence of the president
- Continue to Hafnarfjörður and Lake Kleifarvatn
- See geothermal activity in Krísuvik geothermal field
- Visit and bathe in the Blue Lagoon
- Board your flight for home
