Despite being ravaged by both World Wars, much of the city still stands proud, including the twin copper domes of the Frauenkirche, and Marienplatz, once the intersection of medieval trade routes. Your visit also includes an excursion to breathtaking Neuschwanstein Castle, a somber visit to Dachau, and a student exchange or German language and culture class.



What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Germany

Day 2: Munich

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Munich, where you'll experience the medieval to the modern. During your stay you'll see the Olympic Stadium, BMW headquarters, the fashionable Schwabing district and the Residenz, former home of the Wittelsbach dukes of Bavaria. Visit Dachau, a WWII Nazi concentration camp built in 1933 and liberated by the Allies in 1945. It now serves as a memorial museum. In Marienplatz, see the neo-Gothic New City Hall with its famous Glockenspiel. Then continue past the famous Hofbräuhaus, once the royal brewery of the Kingdom of Bavaria.
- Take a walking tour of Munich: Frauenkirche;
 Neues Rathaus; Hofbräuhaus

Day 3: Munich

- Take a guided tour of Munich: Olympic Stadium; Residenz; Marienplatz
- Visit Dachau

Day 4: Munich

- Participate in a student exchange or attend a German language and culture class
- Take a bike tour (March-November) or BMW museum tour (December-February)

Day 5: Munich

Full day to explore more of Munich or
 Excursion to Salzburg and the Salt Mines

Day 6: Munich

- Take an excursion to Neuschwanstein Castle, the real-life model for Disneyland's Sleeping Beauty Castle. Perched in the Bavarian Alps, this fairy-tale castle was the brainchild of "Mad" King Ludwig. Learn about the life and mysterious death of the young king, one of Europe's most eccentric rulers. King Ludwig so preferred dreams over reality that his servants could address him only from behind a screen. In fact, the original plans for the castle were drawn up by a theater set designer, not an architect.

Day 7: Depart for home

Day 7: Berlin

- Travel by train to Berlin, the vibrant capital of reunified Germany. The city has been transformed since the Berlin Wall fell in 1989 and now plays a vital role in the European Union. During your stay you'll visit the Checkpoint Charlie museum, named after the checkpoint station that once guarded the border between East and West Germany. Here you can see escape cars, hot air balloons and even a submarine—all used in risky border crossings. Stroll past cafés, restaurants and embassies along Unter den Linden, Berlin's most elegant boulevard. Continue to the imposing Reichstag building, the historical seat of Germany's parliament.
- Take a walking tour of Berlin: Unter den Linden; Reichstag

Day 8: Berlin

- Take a guided tour of Berlin: Brandenburg Gate; Kurfürstendamm; Remains of the Berlin Wall
- Enjoy free time in Berlin

Day 9: Depart for home
