



What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly to the United Arab Emirates

Day 2: Dubai

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport

Day 3: Abu Dhabi

- Travel to Abu Dhabi, the cosmopolitan capital city of the UAE. With a rich history dating back to around 3000 B.C., Abu Dhabi features a fascinating mix of Arabian tradition and 21st century progress. At the Sheikh Zayed Mosque, named for the country's first president, you will gain a deeper understanding of the the region's cultural diversity as you walk beneath the complex's 80 domes, 1,000 columns and 24 carat gold-plated chandeliers. Equally as impressive are the 7-star, \$6 billion Emirates Palace Hotel and the brand-new Abu Dhabi Louvre museum. Just outside the city, away from the glitz and glamour, you'll experience the region's more rugged side on an unforgettable desert safari.
- Take a guided tour of Abu Dhabi Falcon Hospital
- Explore the desert on a safari

Day 4: Abu Dhabi

- Take a tour of Abu Dhabi
- Visit Sheikh Zayed Mosque
- See the Emirates Palace Hotel
- Take an expertly guided tour of Masdar City, one of the world's first eco-cities powered by solar and other renewable energy sources. Masdar means "the source" in Arabic, and the planned city is designed to be a source of expertise in renewable energy, clean technologies, and sustainable urban development and design. You'll visit the city's first tenant, the Masdar Institute of Science and Technology, which opened its six-building campus in 2010. A 45-meter tall wind tower pushes a cooling breeze through the city streets, where cars are not allowed. Instead, you will ride on the city's futuristic personal rapid transit system—a computer-guided, driverless vehicle. The city, expected to be completed in 2025, will eventually cover 2.3 square miles and be home to nearly 40,000 residents and 1,500 businesses.

Day 5: Abu Dhabi | Dubai

- Travel to Saadiyat Island
- Visit the Abu Dhabi Louvre
- Travel to Dubai, a city that has transformed from a desert outpost to major international trade center in just 20 years time. As you'll quickly discover, the city is a living testament to human endeavor. Many of the world's biggest businesses can be found in Dubai's glittering, ultra-modern skyscrapers, which has created an incredibly diverse, multicultural city (nearly 80% of the population is ex-patriots). But you will still experience Dubai's distinctive Arabian culture as you explore the textile, gold and spice souks. A question and answer session at the Sheikh Mohammed Centre for Cultural Understanding will help put it all into perspective.

Day 6: Dubai

- Take an expertly guided tour of Old Town Dubai and the Bur Dubai Souq
- Visit the Dubai Museum
- Take an expertly guided tour of the Creekside Diwan Mosque and Textile Souk
- Travel by abra boat across Dubai Creek to Deira
- Visit the Gold Souk and Spice Souk
- Participate in a Q&A at the Sheikh
 Mohammed Centre for Cultural Understanding

Day 7: Dubai

- Visit the Dubai Aquarium and Underwater
 Zoo at the Dubai Mall
- Visit the Burj Khalifa
- Watch the Dancing Fountains
